As we are now over half-way through the autumn term, I wanted to share some of the positive developments we've seen across school, particularly in relation to behaviour and standards.

Thank you for your support in making sure your child comes to school in the correct uniform and ready to learn. This helps us start the day without barriers and makes a big difference. Working together with you is very important, and we really appreciate your help.

In September, we repeated our Kick Start initiative, dedicating curriculum time to ensure all students understood how our school operates, how to stay safe both in and out of school, and how to make the most of every learning opportunity. This proactive approach has had a clear impact:


- We have seen a **34% reduction** in the number of fixed term suspensions this term, building on the improvements made last year.
- We have seen a **26% reduction** in the number of students who are suspended.
- Lessons around the school continue to be disruption free and extremely positive environments for students to learn. Those of you who have been into school on the various tour opportunities will have seen this for yourselves.

Looking ahead, we will be running a refreshed version of Kick Start in January, when students return from the Christmas break. This will help everyone reset, refocus, and prepare for a positive spring term.

The students at our school consistently rise to the challenge and do both themselves and us proud. Well done to every student for their positive approach to their lessons, extra-curricular events and overall school experience this term.
