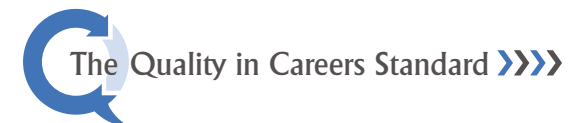

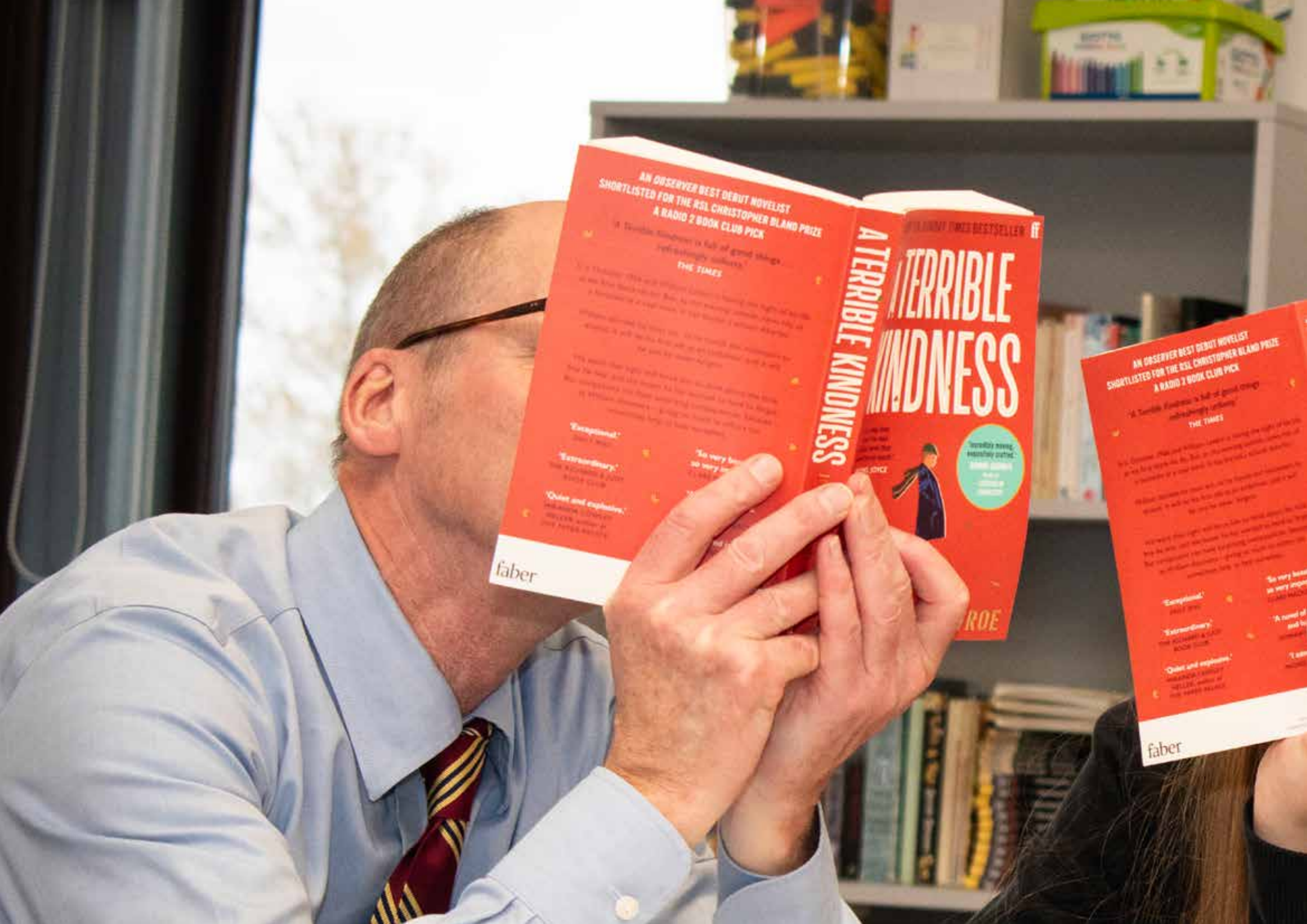

Wellbeing and Pastoral Care

At Ken Stimpson Academy, we recognise that a student's wellbeing is paramount to their academic success and personal development. Our commitment to providing exceptional pastoral care ensures that each student feels safe, supported, and valued throughout their educational journey.

Our experienced and compassionate pastoral team is here to nurture and guide every student. They play a pivotal role in promoting a positive and inclusive school environment, offering a listening ear and practical support when needed.

Staff and student wellbeing ambassadors work alongside our Heads of Year and Student Support Officers to promote positive mental health. Mentoring, wellbeing workshops, and peer support encourage our students to connect and support one another, fostering a sense of belonging to our school community.

All students at KSA have the right to develop their learning, skills and knowledge in a safe, secure and supportive environment, free from intimidation, prejudice or discrimination of any kind, and they should be guided to extend this beyond school into the wider community. Bullying at KSA is unacceptable and it will not be tolerated. All institutions contain some students with the potential for exhibiting bullying behaviour. KSA has a clear policy on the promotion of good citizenship, where it is made clear to students that bullying is a form of anti-social behaviour. A preventative approach to bullying and the importance of respecting others is also taught in Personal Development lessons, assemblies and is promoted in all aspects of KSA life.

Over the past decade, our Post 16 results have gone from strength to strength, and we have consistently been rated as a 'red hot' performer according to the ALPS value added measure, which has put us in the top 25% of sixth forms nationally. Over the last 6 years we have had a 100% A Level pass rate and many of our students have achieved the very highest A Level and vocational outcomes.

More and more of our students choose to study at the leading Russell Group universities or have secured highly competitive degree level apprenticeships. We have a wide range of academic and vocational pathways and have expertise in the areas of business and social sciences. We will work with you to choose the most suitable pathway to ensure that you can progress into your chosen career.

You will be fully supported by our experienced Post 16 team. We also have a Careers Lead and UCAS Lead on hand to guide you as you make your Post 18 decisions. Life within the Ken Stimpson sixth form is about far more than achieving a set of qualifications. We are proud of the extracurricular achievements of our students.

In recent years, our Young Enterprise teams have been consistently amongst the very best in the region and two of our teams have reached the Company of the Year National Final, a feat no other Peterborough team has achieved! Our students have also taken part in the Mock Bar Trial legal challenge and Peer Mentoring programmes, and we have hosted several debates within the sixth form, such as a political '*hustings*' before the last General Election and a recent climate change debate prior to the COP26 summit.
