GCSE French Speaking Intervention

Dear Parent/Carer,

In preparation for the speaking component of the GCSE French exam, we are providing speaking intervention sessions for all Year 11 French students.

These sessions take place during afternoon tutor times and will offer students the opportunity to practise example tasks to prepare them for the demands of the speaking test.

All students will attend one session per week and have been informed of the day they should attend. Students can check their intervention session day by referring to the signs posted outside every Languages classroom or by speaking with their French teacher.

Additionally, we have arranged for speaking mock exams to take place shortly after half-term. These will be conducted by class teachers and will give students a valuable chance to practise all elements of the speaking exam. Your child will be informed of the date and time of their mock speaking exam over the next few days.

We hope that you will encourage your child to attend and participate fully in their intervention sessions, as they are designed to improve skills and increase confidence ahead of the speaking exam.
