1. Travel Details

Departure date: Sunday 15th February 2026

16:20 – Depart Iceland on Icelandair Flight FI454

19:30 – Arrive at London Heathrow Airport, Terminal 2

2. Passport & Travel Documents

All students must bring a valid passport (minimum 6 months remaining), any required visas, and any medical/medication documentation already submitted. Passports must be kept in hand luggage.

3. Luggage Guidance

Checked Luggage: 1 × checked bag – 23kg maximum weight; maximum size 158 cm / 62 inches (height + length + depth)

Personal Item: 1 × personal item (handbag/small laptop bag) that fits under the seat, max size 40 × 30 × 15 cm

All luggage must be labelled.

4. Clothing, Footwear & Equipment

Students should pack warmly and appropriately for Icelandic weather, including waterproof clothing and walking boots.

**Important – Cleats / Ice Grips (Highly Recommended since speaking with our tour guide)
It is likely to be very icy at many of the sites we will be visiting, and cleats will make movement easier and safer. A few recommendations are listed below as an option on Amazon**
