Dear Parents and Carers,


As part of our Red Nose Day fundraising events taking place tomorrow, a number of our students will be running stalls selling homemade food items, including cakes and other treats, to raise money for charity.

Students will be listing the ingredients used in their homemade items; however, we would like to make parents aware that, as these products are made at home, **we cannot guarantee the absence of cross-contamination** (for example with nuts, dairy, gluten or other allergens). For this reason, we strongly advise that **students with food allergies or intolerances do not purchase or consume any homemade items** from these stalls.

To ensure that all students can still take part in the day should they wish to, we will also have a dedicated stall selling **allergy-friendly food options**. These items will be prepared and handled with the necessary controls in place, and students with allergies are welcome to purchase from this stall.

Thank you for your support in helping us run a safe and successful Red Nose Day event, and for your continued encouragement of our students' charity efforts.
