RE: Triple Science Option and Course Expectations

Your son/daughter has chosen Triple Science as one of their option subjects. During the Year 8 Pathways Evening, we outlined that students must demonstrate both the *attitude* and *aptitude* required to successfully study Triple Science.

At present, all students are being taught the Triple *Higher* content. I am writing to inform you that your son/daughter may be at risk of being moved to Triple *Foundation* or to Combined Science (Higher or Foundation) following their Year 10 or Year 11 mock exams, should they not demonstrate the expected levels of effort, engagement, and progress.

To remain on the Triple Science pathway, students must demonstrate:

- **Appropriate Attitude:**
Being consistently focused and engaged in lessons, completing all classwork to a high standard, and completing all Sparx Science homework each week.
- **Appropriate Aptitude:**
Achieving **at least three Grade 5s** (one in each of Biology, Chemistry, and Physics) in their Year 10 and/or Year 11 mock exams.

We are committed to working closely with you and your son/daughter to ensure they make strong progress and achieve the best possible outcomes. With consistent effort, the right support, and a positive attitude to learning, success in Triple Science is absolutely achievable.
