Dear Parents/Carer,

As we prepare for our upcoming **School Ski Trip to Salzburger Sportwelt, Austria (28 March – 4 April 2026)**, please find below the final details to ensure your child is fully prepared for departure.

Departure Information

- Students must arrive at **Manor Drive for 5:30pm on Saturday 28 March 2026**.
- Please ensure your child has their **passport** and **EHIC/GHIC card** readily available for checking before boarding.
- The journey will take approximately **24 hours**, so comfort and preparation are essential.

Coach Journey – What Students Need

Please ensure your child:

- Is dressed in **comfortable clothing** for the long journey.
- Brings their **own food and drink** for the bus, as nothing will be provided during the journey.
- Has a **small pillow or travel cushion** to rest during the 24-hour coach trip.
- Brings a **small rucksack** for personal items they may need on the journey.

The rucksack should include:

- Food and drinks for the journey.
- A toothbrush & personal essentials.
- A **pair of ski socks**, which must be easily accessible for ski boot fitting upon arrival.
- Spare set of clothes if needed.
- Any medication required during travel (to be handed to staff if appropriate)

Please note:

Any luggage placed under the coach will not be accessible until we reach the hotel in Austria, so essential items must be kept in their rucksack.

Money and Additional Purchases


- Any food, drink, or items purchased **outside of what is provided by the ski company** must be paid for by the individual student.
- Students may bring **cash or a prepaid card** for personal spending.
- All money or cards brought on the trip are the **student's own responsibility**.

General Reminders

- Please ensure all personal belongings are **clearly named**.
