School Ski Trip 2027 – Val di Fiemme, Italy

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to launch our **School Ski Trip 2027** to the beautiful **Val di Fiemme** region of Italy. The trip will depart on **Saturday 27 March 2027** and return on **Saturday 03 April 2027** (exact travel times will be confirmed closer to departure).

This exciting opportunity will allow students to develop their skiing skills while building confidence, resilience, independence and teamwork in a stunning Alpine setting. Val di Fiemme is a highly regarded ski area and is well suited to both beginners and more experienced skiers.

Student Eligibility and Places

There are **40 places available** for students currently in **Years 7–10**. Should the trip not reach the minimum number of participants, we will look to combine with another school within our trust to ensure viability.

Students currently in **Year 11** may also apply for a place. Year 11 students must pay the initial deposit to secure a **provisional place**. Final confirmation will be subject to the student securing a place at **KSA Sixth Form in August 2026**. Once confirmed, a separate Year 11 payment plan will be emailed to parents/carers.

Places will be allocated on a **first-come, first-served basis** and are subject to **behaviour, attendance and medical suitability**. If demand exceeds available places, a waiting list will be created. If minimum numbers are not met, the trip may be cancelled.

Travel Arrangements

Travel will be by touring coach, including a return short sea ferry crossing from Dover to Calais.

Accommodation

Hotel accommodation is to be confirmed and will be dependent on final group size.

- Students will be accommodated in **multi-bedded rooms**
- All rooms have **private facilities**
