Dear Parents/Carers,

We are pleased to offer students the opportunity to attend an exciting Netball Super League fixture at Loughborough University.

The trip will be to watch Loughborough Lightning vs Nottingham Forest on Friday 15th May at the Sir David Wallace Sports Hall. Prior to the main fixture, there will also be a Netball Super League NextGen match, giving students the opportunity to watch emerging elite players in action.

This trip is open to **Year 7 and Year 8 students** who either play in the school netball teams or regularly attend school netball training.

Risk level	Description of activities
Low Risk	Local trip, routinely occurs, limited travel, no adventurous activities, within school hours, good levels of supervision.
Medium Risk	Some adventurous activities included, more extensive travel, higher levels of potential interaction with members of the public, extended hours, good levels of supervision.
High Risk	Adventurous activities, residential, extensive travel/abroad, extended trip length, involves activities interacting with water, minimal or lack of supervision (Duke of Edinburgh Scheme/Secondary School only)

This trip is considered a Medium Risk trip.

Event Schedule

- Depart KSA: 2:30pm
- Gates open: 4:00pm
- Curtain Raiser (NextGen): 4:30pm
Loughborough Lightning NextGen vs Nottingham Forest NextGen
- First centre pass (Super League match): 7:00pm

Transport will be provided by KSA via the school minibus. We aim to depart Loughborough University at approximately 9:15pm, with an expected return to KSA around 10:30pm. Students will update parents once we have set off on the return journey.

As the trip departs during the school day, students should bring a change of clothes to change into before leaving school.

The cost of the trip is £11, which covers entry to both the NextGen game and the main Super League fixture. There are 14 places available, which will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Payment should be made via ParentPay. ParentPay is now open and places will be confirmed once payment has been received.

Students will need to provide their own food; however, there will be opportunities to purchase food at the venue. Official merchandise will also be available to buy, should students wish, so they may bring a small amount of additional spending money. There may also be an opportunity for students to meet players, take photos, or collect autographs.

Students are expected to behave responsibly at all times and to follow school expectations while representing Ken Stimpson Academy.
