Dear Parent/Carer

We are delighted to announce a **Flash Reward** for all students. This will take the form of a **non-uniform day on Friday**. The reward is to recognise attendance efforts, excellent behaviour stats and an amazing number of school wide positives. When we all get it so right, we should celebrate together.

Students wishing to take part in the non-uniform day will be required to bring **£1**, which will be collected on entry to school. All money raised will go directly to the school's student fund.

Students who do not wish to participate, or who do not bring £1, are expected to attend school in **full school uniform**. Any student arriving in incorrect uniform without the £1 will have their name recorded, and parents/carers will be contacted.

The student fund will be used to support further rewards **for students during the next half-term**. Importantly, these rewards will be decided in consultation with our **School Council**, ensuring that students from all year groups have a voice in shaping future incentives and celebrations.

Clothing Guidance

While students are welcome to wear their own clothes, we ask that they dress in a way that is respectful and appropriate for a school environment. Please ensure the following expectations are met:


- Clothing must be **modest and not revealing**
- No **offensive, political or conflict-related slogans or imagery**
- No **onesies or fancy dress**
- No **extreme hairstyles or unnatural hair colours**
- No **excessive makeup or face paint**
- No **long nail extensions** (short extensions and discreet nail varnish are acceptable)
- No **ripped jeans, short skirts or cropped tops**

Students who do not meet these expectations may be asked to change or may be placed in the **Internal Exit Unit (IEU)** for the day. Parents/carers may be contacted to bring in alternative clothing if required.

Students who prefer to attend in full school uniform are, of course, welcome to do so. Those with PE on Friday must still bring their **PE kit or a suitable change of sportswear**, regardless of whether they are taking part in the non-uniform day.
