- > Drive through Grindavik to see the cooling lava from the 2023-2025 eruptions
- > Go underground in the **Raufarhólshellir Lava Tunnel**
- > Head to Reykjavik – world's most northern capital city
- > Tour in Reykjavik and free time
- > **Fly Over Iceland** – See all of Iceland in this exciting ride!
- > See real lava up close at the **Icelandic Lava Show**
- > Dinner of **Fish and Chips in Grindavik**
- > Finish at **Hotel Ork**

DAY TWO

- > On to the beautiful South Coast of Iceland
- > Seljalandsfoss (60m waterfall you can walk behind)
- > Skógarfoss (25m wide and 60m tall waterfall)

- > **Evening swim in heated pool with Lifeguard**

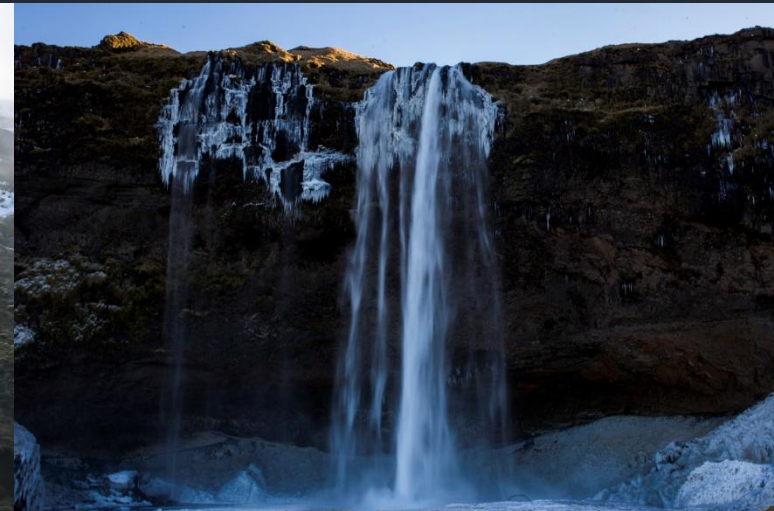


DAY THREE
