Year 11 - Final update

Dear Parent/Carer,

We now enter the final stretch of exams. I again want to highlight how impressed we have been with the way a vast majority of students have approached their exams. I would also like to extend my appreciation to all the staff who have run booster sessions prior to exams. Below, are some final updates regarding exams and beyond.

Study Leave

As previously communicated study leave has now commenced.

Students will now only need to arrive for Exams and remaining booster lessons. They no longer need to attend morning tutor - for morning exams we ask students still arrive to school by 8.45 am to ensure they are on time for their exams. If they remain in school for the afternoon, then they will no longer have a tutor session in the afternoon and will have a 'double' lunch instead from 1.15-2.15pm.

For students who wish to remain on site after exams or choose to study at school we will be providing a dedicated, supervised space. We do ask that students who wish to utilise this space ensure they have revision materials that can be accessed with and without a computer. There will not be dedicated teaching during this time and students will be responsible for their own self-guided revision.

Uniform collection – Friday 12th June

If you and your child no longer have any use for their school uniform the school warmly welcomes donations of blazers, ties and PE kit. Donated uniform will be washed and used to support any student who requires either a temporary or permanent loan.

We will be running the uniform collection on Friday 12th of June prior to the science exam. After this date any student with remaining exams will only be required to wear their school shirts, trousers and shoes.

Graduation – Friday 19th June

Graduation Day will take place on Friday 19th June, the event will start promptly at 9.00am, students can start arriving to school from 8:30am onwards. In previous years the even has finished around 11.30am.

Year 11 Prom - Wednesday 24th June

This will be held at the Peterborough Marriott. A final letter with arrangements for the night and your son/daughter's Prom ticket has been distributed. If you have any additional queries, please do get in contact.

Post 16 Induction - Friday 26th June to Wednesday 1st July

This is compulsory for all students with an offer of a place in our sixth form. Induction will take place from Friday 26th June to Wednesday 1st July. A letter will be circulated shortly, which will include details of a Lincoln university trip on Tuesday 30th June as part of the induction process.

Results Day – Thursday 20th August, 08.30 -10.30 (Assembly Hall).

Only students can collect their results. If they are unable to do so at the above time, then they have two options:

- 1- Results can be posted. Students will need to drop off a stamped addressed envelope to the Exams Office (3L09) before the end of term.
- 2- If they want someone else to pick up their results on the day, they need to send an email (or letter) to our Exams Officer: c.leach@kenstimpson.org.uk. The email/ letter must clearly state the name of the person who they give authorisation to collect on their behalf. Furthermore, the person coming to collect must bring in some I.D.
