Dear Parent/Carer

Due to the predicted high temperatures next week, we have decided to try and offer some early clarity and as much pre-information as possible.

From Monday (6th July) students are permitted to wear their KSA PE Kit for the entire week. Alternatively, students may wear their normal school uniform with ties and blazers optional.

PE kits should adhere to the usual PE kit guidelines and will be held to the same standards as normal uniform (shorts should be of a suitable length, Nike pro or equivalent shorts are not permitted, any tight-fitting shorts must be at least thigh length).

Unfortunately, there have been too many examples where students were wearing shorts that were inappropriate in length. As a result, we are now reviewing the PE kit guidance for September. It is highly likely that we will move to: no tight fitting / lycra style shorts at all.

It is our intention to remain open each day and we are not looking to close early. The message remains the same, which is to send your children to school as often as possible.

Depending on the temperatures each day, we will look to again adapt the school day to enable additional water and toilet breaks.

We also urge students to apply sunscreen before arriving at school and to bring a water bottle to stay hydrated throughout the day. Students will be advised to remain in shaded areas during break times.

Hats may be worn but should be removed while inside the school buildings.
