Good afternoon,

As of **Monday 14th September 2026**, unit 6 will be commencing for all Year 11 students. These sessions will be running from 15:15 and will end at 16:00 on a **Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday**, with **Wednesday** reserved for wellbeing.

Your child's timetable will detail what Unit 6 is taking place on each day:

- Maths and English will remain in place for the duration of the academic year
- Options subjects placed on a half termly rotation.

Over the past two years we have found that **Unit 6 has played a vital role in raising the attainment of students**. Unit 6 provide students with almost an additional 70 hours of extra learning, with subject specialists who know both your child and the courses best.
