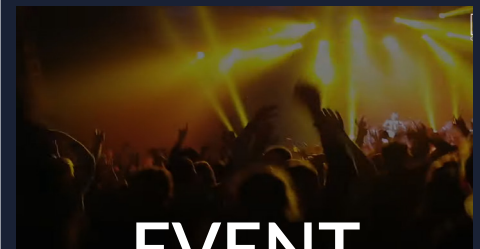
Welcome to our **Summer Half-term** Careers Newsletter!
