To combine this requirement with one of our topics (Ecosystems), we have decided to take the cohort on a day's long fieldtrip to a local section of land to survey the area.

The area in question is just off Foxcovert Road near the train tracks. This managed land offers a range of different ecosystems in which students can apply what they have learnt in the classroom and gain valuable experience of conducting and writing research — a highly sought after skill in the higher education sector as well as future careers.
