**Re: Invitation to take Triple Science in Years 10 and 11**

Triple Science consists of three separate GCSE's in Biology, Chemistry and Physics. To teach the additional content, we will be delivering the Triple Science qualification through once weekly Unit 6 lessons at the end of the normal school day (3.15-4.15pm). These will start from Monday 5 June this year and continue up to the final exams in year 11. The after-school lessons will give us the extra time needed to teach the additional content that the Triple Science course contains while still delivering the Combined Science content worth two GCSE's during normal lesson time.
