Local Skills Improvement Plans

Local Skills Improvement Plans (LSIP) represents a new approach to addressing skills gaps; one that is tailored to the region and ensures every voice is heard. By putting the voice of local employers at the heart of the learning and skills system, it will help the post-16 education and training provision better meet the needs of local employers.



The Cambridgeshire Chamber of Commerce is leading the LSIP in our region and will consider the current and future local skills needs identified by the employers. The final plan will outline what employers, training providers and stakeholders can do locally to support the delivery of training that meets those future skills needs.

It is expected that our plan will be agreed by the Secretary of State in Summer 2023 and the LSIP will initially run up to March 2025 with regular reviews to ensure they remain relevant.

Training providers are under a duty to co-operate and consider the LSIPs when constructing their post-16 technical education or training offer.
