Dear Parent/Carer,

As you may be aware King Charles III's coronation is taking place on Saturday 6th May. There is also a bank holiday on Monday 8th of May.

At Ken Stimpson Community School we would like to hold our own event on **Friday 5th of May** to mark the historic occasion with a **non-uniform day** and "**street party**". All students are encouraged to come into school dressed in red, blue and white.

Heads of Year and other staff will be on hand at the gates in the morning to collect any **voluntary donations** which will all go to The Princes Trust, one of the King's charities. Each year group will also be having a 'street party' which will take place on unit 5 where lessons will be collapsed to allow students to join their year group and form tutors to celebrate. All other lessons will remain unaffected and will continue as normal.


Unit 5 will involve a host of activities including nibbles, drinks, music and games to celebrate the coronation. The school will be providing nibbles, but students can bring in items of food to share. Food should be non-perishable and passed onto form tutors.

Furthermore, the canteen will be serving a special coronation lunch menu. We also have an Art competition linked to the coronation where the winning artworks will be displayed in the canteen and the students will receive a prize.

Whilst it is an **optional non-uniform day**, we ask students to dress appropriately (no offensive or revealing clothing such as crop tops, hot pants or miniskirts or anything inappropriate). Our normal rules on behaviour, phones, piercings and jewellery (maximum one ring per hand and one plain round metal stud per ear only) still apply. The final decision on the suitability of clothes and their compliance with this policy will be down to each Head of Year.

We are really looking forward to celebrating this momentous occasion with our students.
