

Key Guidance Year 10



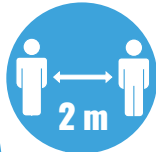
Start of the School Day

Arrival will be managed by school staff.

Year 10 students will arrive at staggered times in their bubble groups which they will remain in for the rest of the day.

Students will be made aware in advance of their groupings.

Facemasks must be worn if travelling on public transport to and from school but should be removed upon arrival until further notice.



Wellbeing

The school leadership and pastoral teams will be available to ease tensions and anxiety, whilst ensuring that students are social distancing.



Entering the School

Staff will direct bubble groups to use specified entrance points and wash hands upon entry.



Classroom Expectations

Students will enter the classroom upon arrival, they will not line up outside.

Staff will welcome students from a socially distanced position.

Students will be given their seating positions in advance of arriving to prevent unnecessary movement.

Seating plans are **non-negotiable** and fixed.

You must bring all necessary equipment.

Equipment cannot be borrowed from others.



End of the School Day

Students will leave the classroom in a rehearsed manner via planned exit routes in their bubble's.

Staff will be on duty to supervise the exit routes. Students will be advised and reminded not to wait for their friends from different bubbles.

Any students travelling using school buses or contracted taxis will follow a plan to access their transport which includes socially distanced queuing. Parents/carers are reminded to maintain social distancing rules when collecting students.



Arriving Late

Students arriving late will need to report to reception where they will be escorted to the appropriate room.



Movement Around school

Non-essential movement around school will be avoided.

A toilet rota will be in place to prevent busy queues during break times.

Staff will supervise safe movement in corridors.

Support staff are available to support wellbeing issues.



Uniform, Equipment and Expectations

Students should wear their usual school uniform when inside of school: a shirt, tie, trousers/skirt, school shoes and blazer (if they have one).

Students will need to bring their own equipment and a drink/snack if required. The canteen will not be available to Year 10 students.

Any lack of compliance will result in the school applying sanctions - this could result in a temporary withdrawal of placement or a complete withdrawal of placement.
