

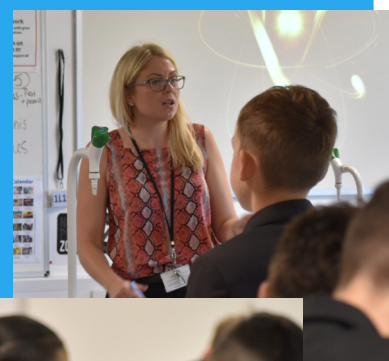
YEAR 10 NEWS LETTER
