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
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BREELS

I am pleased to announce that we will be offering daily a free breakfast provision starting with Years 7,8 and Post 16 from Monday November 1. To ensure we get the service and provision correct, we will not start serving Years 9, 10 to 11 until Monday 15 November.



The breakfast provision will be:

- 1.A hot bagel (dry or with spread and/or jam)
- 2. Cereal (Cornflakes, Rice Crispies, Shreddies and gluten free cornflakes)
- 3. A hot drink (chocolate, tea and decaf coffee)

It is a free entitlement for all students and will be served in the canteen from 8.00 to 8.25 am. The serving of a hot drink will cease at 8.20am.

The canteen will be staffed each day and the facility will be segregated into lower and upper school areas.

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Year11Unit6



We are proud to be announcing that from half term we will be launching unit 6. This is an extra lesson each day for students in year 11 which will enable them to maximise their progress towards their GCSEs. We have used unit 6 with previous year 11 cohorts and it has proven successful in helping them revise and work towards their target grades.

Monday: Maths and English (split by year half). In week 1 A half students will go to Maths whilst of where to go they can see their class teacher, student support officer or head of year.

Tuesday: Health and Social Care, MFL, Art



Thursday: Dance, Drama, Music, Geography, Computer Science, IT (iMedia), Construction, PE

Friday: Business Studies (starting in January)

What time does it start and finish? Unit 6 launches on 01 November 2021 and each session will start 3:15 and finish 4:15pm.

Does my child have to attend? We expect students to make a conscious decision that this will help them, and not accessing the sessions may not help them succeed in the immediate future.

Are you asking students to do more? Students should be revising each day at this stage for a minimum of an hour a day. This is a way in which students can make their revision more worthwhile with an expert in front of them delivering key topics.

What happens on Thursday if my child has multiple options on at the same time? The students have a choice of which subject they attend. This should ideally be the one they are weakest in. Alternatively, they could find out from their teachers what is going to be covered and then make a choice based on the content being delivered.



What happens on a Tuesday or a Friday if my child does not do any of those subjects? Students are welcome to attend our homework club (in room 1L50 which is open Monday — Thursday) where they can do independent revision. The room will be supervised by a member of staff. On Friday's students could look to do independent revision at home.
