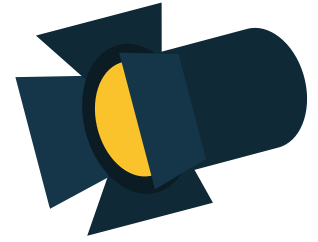

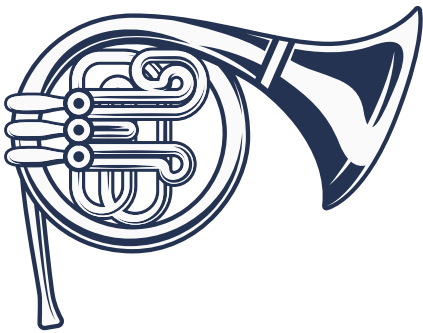

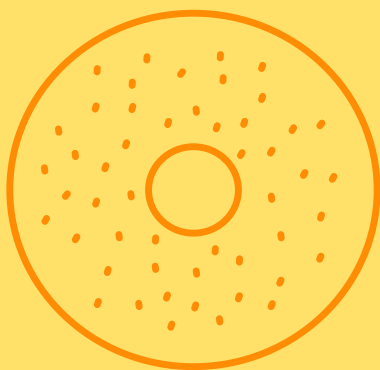
BREAKFAST

Time

I am pleased to announce that we will be offering daily a free breakfast provision starting with years 7,8 and Post16 from Monday November 1. To ensure we get the service and provision correct, we will not start serving years 9, 10 to 11 until Monday 15 November.

The breakfast provision will be:

1. A hot bagel (dry or with spread and/or jam)
2. Cereal (Cornflakes, Rice Crispies, Shreddies and gluten free cornflakes)
3. A hot drink (chocolate, tea and decaf coffee)



It is a free entitlement for all students and will be served in the canteen from 8.00 to 8.25 am. The serving of a hot drink will stop at 8.20am.

The canteen will be staffed each day and the facility will be segregated into lower and upper school areas.

I hope that this service will be actively taken up by the students.
